About the *Breathe Better Network*



Our National Partnership Network

Organizations and programs of all sizes across the country, including state and federal agencies, nonprofits, civic groups, professional associations, health systems, and research organizations, make up the *Breathe Better Network*, coordinated by the ***Learn More Breathe Better***[®] program of the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI).

Together, *Network* partners bring greater visibility to lung health for all Americans. Specifically, they help:

- Drive educational efforts to increase understanding of lung health, including chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and asthma as serious yet treatable conditions.
- Educate health professionals and patients about ways to treat and manage COPD, asthma, and other lung diseases and conditions.
- Encourage people to talk to a healthcare provider about their lung health, especially if they are experiencing any symptoms or changes to their breathing.

Support from NHLBI

Breathe Better Network partners benefit in a number of ways:

- Get easy access to *Learn More Breathe Better* resources.
- Acknowledgment as a partner on the ***Network webpage***.
- Use of *Learn More Breathe Better* program materials, including fact sheets, videos, and more for healthcare providers, patients and caregivers.
- Receive regular program and Institute updates.
- Connect to other *Network* partners to facilitate collaboration.
- Have opportunities for possible cross-promotion of events and resources
- Have the opportunity to request NHLBI subject matter experts as available to support programming.
- Have a direct connection to NHLBI and can help shape current and future education efforts for *Learn More Breathe Better*.

Broad-ranging Resources

Partners have access to a variety of print and digital materials, including public service announcements, videos, fact sheets and brochures, social media tools, teaching tools, and more. The materials are designed for people with and at risk for lung diseases, their family members and caregivers, researchers, and healthcare providers. Partners are the first to know when new materials become available.

Each year, partners have the opportunity to join NHLBI and the *Learn More Breathe Better* program for observance months, including **Asthma and Allergy Awareness Month** in May and **National COPD Awareness Month** in November. We provide partners with educational resources, tips for outreach, and ideas for hosting events.

A Shared Mission

The *Network* includes state and federal agencies, nonprofits, civic groups, professional associations, advocacy groups, health systems, and research organizations. All participating organizations have a mission that aligns with the *Learn More Breathe Better* goals and objectives.

We welcome organizations that share the goal of increasing awareness of lung diseases and conditions, including, but not limited to, COPD and asthma. Any organization that provides free resources and education to patients, caregivers, and healthcare providers may become a partner.

Increased Reach

We ask our partners to stay engaged in our lung health education efforts:

- Link to *Learn More Breathe Better* from their website.
- Use *Learn More Breathe Better* resources and materials to educate the public, patients, healthcare providers, and other stakeholders in their outreach activities.
- Follow, engage with, and share *Learn More Breathe Better* and NHLBI social media channels and/or content.
- Plan to conduct at least one lung health education activity or event each year using the program's materials.
- Share their activities with NHLBI and other *Network* partners.
- Add a badge to their website (see image at left) showing they are a *Network* member.
